



**INVOLUNTARY DISCHARGE AND
 TERMINATION FROM THE PROGRAM**

An applicant may be removed from the MBOP Tribal Child Care Program for any of the following reasons:

1. **Threats or Violence**
 Any form of threats, intimidation, or violence toward MBOP Tribal Child Care Staff or other applicants will not be tolerated. This includes verbal abuse. Individuals may be asked to leave immediately or removed by law enforcement, which may result in trespassing charges.
2. **Substance Use or Possession**
 Possession or use of drugs, alcohol, or weapons on the premises is strictly prohibited. Being under the influence while on-site may result in removal and possible legal charges for possession or public intoxication.
3. **Theft or Property Damage**
 Attempting to steal or damage program property or the belongings of MBOP Tribal Child Care Staff or other applicants will be reported to law enforcement and may result in charges such as petty theft or destruction of property.
4. **Extended Incarceration**
 If an applicant is convicted and incarcerated for more than (30) days, the case will be closed. A new guardian may apply, and the child(ren) will be placed on the priority list for services.
5. **Non-Participation**
 If an applicant fails to participate or is unable to engage in the program, the case will be reviewed by the Project Director. Your assigned TCC Case Manager will attempt to contact the applicant (3) times by phone and email before sending a closure notice. If there is no response, the case will be closed.
6. **Fraud**
 Providing false or misleading information or documents will result in immediate discharge from the program with possible legal repercussions.
7. **Failure to Provide Required Documentation**
 Applicants must submit all required documents to verify eligibility. Without these, MBOP Tribal Child Care cannot proceed with developing the 12-Month Certificate. Your assigned TCC Case Manager is available to assist with obtaining missing documents.
8. **Misuse of Program Technology**
 Viewing inappropriate content or downloading harmful software on MBOP Tribal Child Care computers is strictly prohibited.
